



Pool Rules

- There is no lifeguard. Residents and/or their guests swim at their own risk. All swimmers should be supervised. No swimming alone.
- The pool season will begin Memorial Day weekend and continue through Labor Day each year.
- The pool hours are from **10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.** daily. If inclement weather occurs, the pool will be considered closed. The pool may be closed for maintenance operations, health conditions, weather, or any other reason deemed sufficient by the Board or its agent, consistent with the welfare and safety of the residents.
- There is a **two (2) guest maximum** per household. Residents must accompany their guests to the pool and remain with them during their swim. The pool and amenities are for the exclusive use of Nathanial's Grove homeowners and their guests. Those not following rules and guidelines could be charged with criminal trespassing. These areas are Private Property and there is No Trespassing.
- Individuals twelve (12) years of age and under must be accompanied by a capable swimmer at all times.
- If ADA lift is present, please follow rules posted on equipment and in facility.
- NO GLASS or breakable containers of any kind shall be permitted within the fenced pool area, in the pool, or on the deck at any time.
- No smoking or vaping within the fenced pool area.
- Food and drink are not permitted in the pool or near the pool edge.
- Proper swim attire is required. No street clothes or undergarments will be allowed to be worn in the water.
- Incontinent individuals are required to wear swim diapers.
- Individuals with skin, eye, ear, or nasal infections or wearing bandages shall not be allowed in the pool. In addition, if you do not feel well, please stay home.
- Umbrellas should be put down when not in use.
- The pool gates must be kept closed at all times except when entering/exiting the facility. The gates should never be propped open.
- Bicycles are not permitted in the pool area or at the pool gate. A bike rack is provided in the parking lot for your convenience. Roller blades, roller skates, skateboards, etc., are not permitted.
- No floats, tennis balls, etc., are permitted in the pool area. All sharp and dangerous objects, small balls, footballs, Frisbees and Nerf balls must be kept out of the pool.
- All trash must be placed in the containers provided.
- Use of barbecue grills in the pool area is prohibited.
- All animals with the exception of service animals are prohibited in the pool area.
- No running, diving, pushing, wrestling, foul language, loud music, or undue disturbance shall be permitted in or about the pool area. Listening devices should be utilized so as not to disturb others.
- Any person trespassing during any hours when the pool is declared closed shall be prosecuted.
- The Board or its agent will not be responsible for loss of or damage to personal property.
- Property damage will be charged to responsible person(s) and access to the facility revoked.
- Pool furniture is for the rest and relaxation of our residents and their guests only. It is not to be used as a diving board or as a play object. The furniture is to remain within the designated pool area.
- All safety equipment is to be used for safety reasons only and not as recreational entertainment.
- The local police department has the authority to revoke pool privileges to persons not abiding by these pool rules and regulations or arrest persons trespassing whom cannot prove that they are a resident of Nathanial's Grove and have the right to use the facility.
- Violation of any of these rules may result in access to the facility being revoked.
